This model is designed to be made using Threat Saw alongside hand carving. It is a jigsaw and if you wish you could leave it at that by making the jigsaw from thin stock, but if you wish to take it a little further you could increase the size of the stock and turn it into a full 3 dimensional model.

To add additional detail it is a good idea to round/shape as many of the edges as possible this increase the 3D impact of the model.

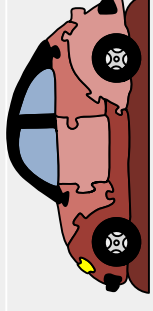
The plan has a single layout. To cut the sections you could either :

- Print and apply the assembled plan onto the stock using spray adhesive the cut out using a saw, or
- Print out cut the sections out with scissors and apply to the stock in the same way cutting each piece separately

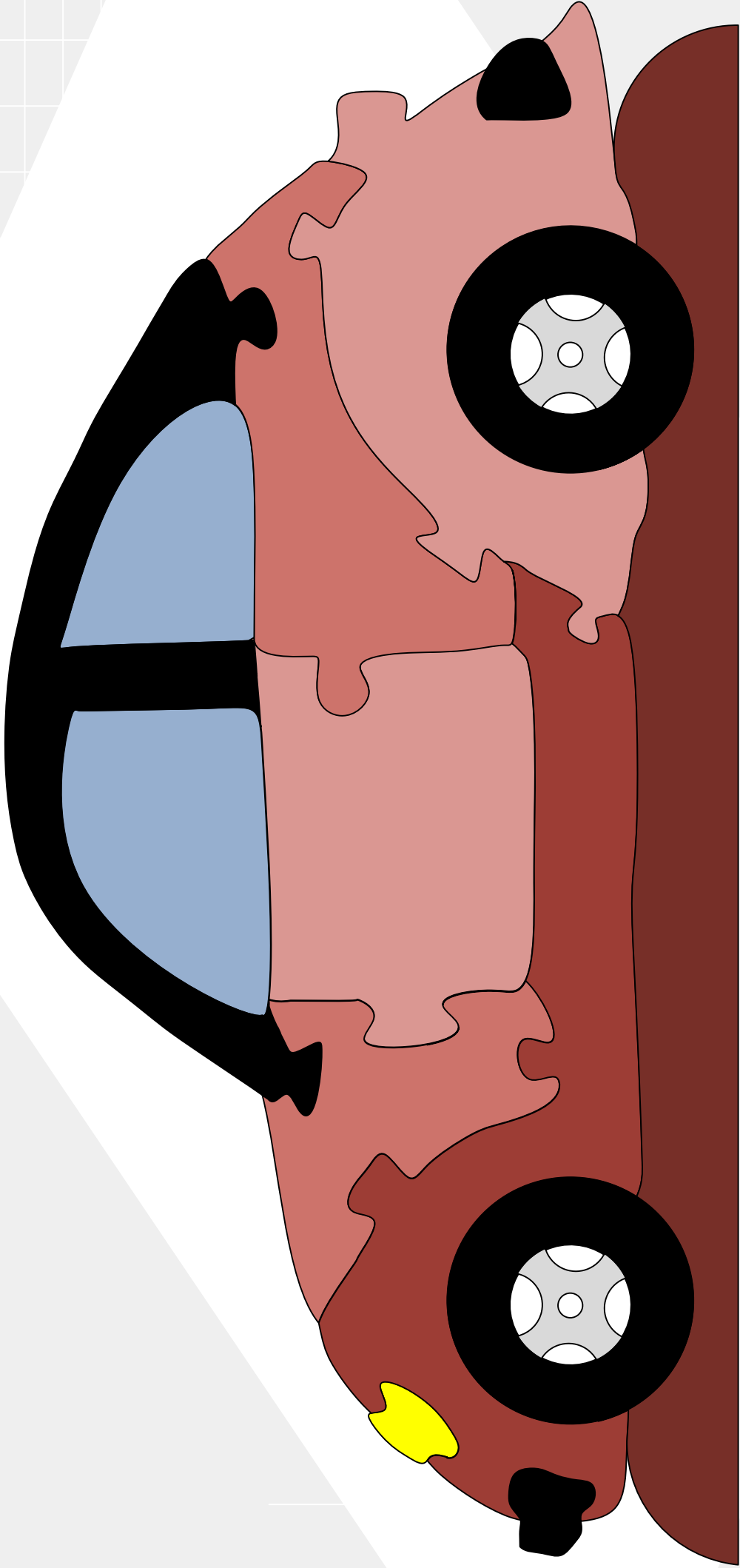
